ares_cancel – Cancel a resolve

SYNOPSIS

DESCRIPTION

The **ares_cancel** function cancels all lookups/requests made on the the name service channel identified by *channel*. **ares_cancel** invokes the callbacks for each pending query on the channel, passing a status of **ARES_ECANCELLED**. These calls give the callbacks a chance to clean up any state which might have been stored in their arguments. If such a callback invocation adds a new request to the channel, that request will *not* be cancelled by the current invocation of **ares_cancel**.

This function was added in c-ares 1.2.0

c-ares 1.6.0 and earlier pass a status of **ARES_ETIMEOUT** instead of **ARES_ECANCELLED**.
