### **DESCRIPTION**

The ares\_parse\_soa\_reply function parses the response to a query of type SOA into a struct ares\_soa\_reply. The parameters abuf and alen give the contents of the response. The result is stored in allocated memory and a pointer to it stored into the variable pointed to by soa\_out. It is the caller's responsibility to free the resulting soa\_out structure when it is no longer needed using the function ares free data

The structure *ares\_soa\_reply* contains the following fields:

The response did not contain an answer to the query.

# ARES\_ENOMEM

Memory was exhausted.
