

NAME

`ares_set_local_dev` – Bind to a specific network device when creating sockets.

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <ares.h>
```

void ares_set_local_dev(ares_channel channel, const char* local_dev_name)
```

DESCRIPTION

The `ares_set_local_dev` function causes all future sockets to be bound to this device with `SO_BINDTODEVICE`. This forces communications to go over a certain interface, which can be useful on multi-homed machines. This option is only supported on Linux, and root privileges are required for the option to work. If `SO_BINDTODEVICE` is not supported or the `setsockopt` call fails (probably because of permissions), the error is silently ignored.
